JEC Awarded Sewage Treatment Contracts in the Philippines

(Hong Kong) Jardine Engineering Corporation (JEC), together with its partners, Kingsford and FF Cruz, have been awarded two sewage treatment projects in the Philippines. The first is for the design and construction of a 40 million litres per day Sewage Treatment Plant in Baybreeze area and the second is for 75 million litres per day Sewage Treatment Plant in Libingan Ng Mga Bayani (LNMB) area. Both projects are tertiary sewage treatment facilities and located in the Taguig City of Philippines. The contract signing ceremony was held on 21st December 2010 in Manila.

The project teams, under the stewardship of JEC Hong Kong and the Philippines will provide the complete design, supply, construction, installation and commissioning, testing, completion and delivery of the waste water treatment plant, inclusive of preliminary treatment, biological treatment, sludge handling facilities, odour control and treatment, Scada (system control and data acquisition) and effluent disposal.

On the award of this project JEC Chief Operating Officer S H Wu said, "We are delighted that JEC will be a part of these important sewage treatment facilities. We look forward to leveraging on JEC's engineering expertise in sewage treatment in Hong Kong for these new projects which are the first of its kind in Manila."

The two contracts will commence in December 2010 while the Baybreeze project is due to be completed in mid 2014, and the LNMB project is to be completed end of 2014.
