

JEC Philippines Awarded Contract by Aboitiz Power Corporation

JEC Philippines has been awarded the contract to rehabilitate the water cooled air-conditioning systems for the Tiwi Geothermal Plant facilities located in the province of Albay in the island of Luzon Philippines. Tiwi Geothermal Plant was founded in 1972 and engages in the generation of electricity.

Tiwi Geothermal Plant is under AP Renewables Inc. (APRI) a wholly-owned subsidiary of Aboitiz Power Corporation. Aboitiz Power is a holding company engaged in the power generation and distribution.

The primary rehabilitation objective is to return the system to a reliable and effective state ensuring adequate cooling and to protect all electrical equipment and apparatus. The contract will commence in November 2010 and is expected to be completed in 2011.

Scope of works includes the following:

- Design, supply and install
- Dismantling, clearing and hauling
- Replacing and remedy of defective parts
- Modify piping configuration
- Insulation of new piping and re-insulation of existing usable pipes
- Air balancing
- Electrical installation and testing
- Testing and commissioning
